YURT 21
THE VIKING YURT

Location: The Canyons Resort; Park City

Size: Seats up to 33 people

Amenities: Live piano music, 4-6 course candlelight dinner, there is no running water or electricity.

Introduction: The Viking Yurt is mountain fine-dining Norwegian style. A 25-minute sleigh ride brings you to the Red Pine Lodge where you are equipped for a short guided cross-country ski or snowshoe trek to the yurt. There are also days available where the sleigh takes you directly to the yurt. This yurt sits on The Canyons Ski Resort in Park City and is equipped with a baby grand piano. A 5-course meal is served.

Fee: Prices vary by month and range from \$100 plus tax and tip, per person to \$150 plus tax and tip, per person. It is recommended that children under 10 do not attend; there is no special pricing for children.

Other: An additional yurt managed by the same people, the Yonder Yurt, is smaller and seats up to 12 people. It is a shorter and less elegant experience than the Viking yurt. A 3-course meal is served. This is for private groups only—you must rent the entire yurt.
