YURT 25 ANTELOPE MEADOWS YURT

Location: Wanship; 10 minutes from Kimball Junction on I-80

Length: Road to yurt approximately 2 miles; Hike to yurt approximately 2.5 miles

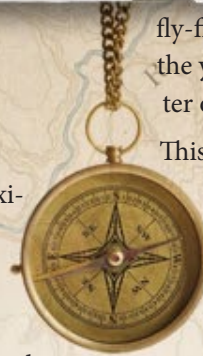
Elevation: The elevation of the barn is approximately 6500'. The elevation of the yurt is approximately 6900'.

Size: Beds include bunk beds and air mattresses. Beds are put up according to the size of your party. Sleeps up to 6.

Difficulty: Road – Easy; Trail – Moderate

Amenities: Solar-powered lights and small appliances, wood stove, cook stove, charcoal grill, coffee maker, attached composting toilet, dishes and utensils for four, large fire pit

Introduction: Blue Sky Adventures is a 3000 acre private ranch just off of I-80 in Wanship. They offer horseback riding, mountain biking, kayaking,



fly-fishing, and group activities. The yurt is one of their offerings. Access to the yurt in the summer includes hiking or driving up a dirt road. In the winter one can Nordic ski, snowshoe, or a snow-cat can bring you up the road.

This yurt is brand new as of 2010 and in immaculate condition. The solar lighting means you can actually turn on lights. The toilet is more civilized than most. And it even sports a laminate floor, which is a first for a Utah yurt. The yurt itself is in great condition with a fun deck around it for lounging, a picnic table and a huge fire pit to roast marshmallows on while kicking back to look at the stars.

The yurt sits on a deck in the middle of rolling hills where wildlife is abundant. On my trip I saw moose and porcupine. Development of added retreat amenities are encroaching. The yurt is located near a reservoir where you can kayak or fish. A stream for fly-fishing is also available. 25 miles of trails for hiking, biking, snowshoeing or Nordic skiing are available. The yurt is available for individuals as well as corporate retreats. Ask about guided tours, dinner service and sleigh ride adventures. Dogs are not allowed

Season: Year-round

Fee: Sunday – Thursday: \$125 night +\$75 each additional night. Friday, Saturday and Holidays: \$175 night + \$100 for each additional night

A non refundable deposit of 1 nightly rate is required in advance. A \$100 cleaning and restocking fee will apply if the yurt and surroundings are not properly cleaned.
