YURTS 9-10: TUSHAR MOUNTAIN TOURS

YURT 9 PUFFER LAKE YURT

Location: Tushar Mountain Range, near Beaver

Length: 2.7 miles

Size: 16' diameter; sleeps 6 on wooden slabs

Elevation: Trailhead: 9700'; Yurt 10,400'

Amenities: Propane two-burner stove for cooking, propane lantern, woodstove for heating the yurt and melting water, wood, axe for splitting wood, shovel, pots and pans, eating utensils, plates, bowls and mugs. A portable chemical toilet is set up outside the yurt. A couple folding chairs are also kept at the yurt.

Introduction: The Puffer Lake Yurt is an easy trek with nice glade skiing right out the front door. City Creek peak, less than an hour away from the peak, has great views of the Tushar Range. Mt. Holly and Lake Peak are also within a day's touring distance. Look for Bald Eagles wintering around the lake.

Season: Mid November through mid May
